


# An Update on COVID-19 in Chile

More than 20 million vaccines have been administered, with 59% of the target population completing the process.




Chile has received slightly more than 22 million vaccines thus far, with supply mainly coming from SINOVAC and Pfizer-BioNTech.

#### COVID-19 Vaccine Doses per Supplier: Recevied & Pending



Cases remain high, with close to 8,000 cases per day, and PCR test positivity rate is roughly at 10%.



The rise in cases has been coupled with greater mobility restrictions; roughly 50% of the population is again under lockdown (Paso 1, area in red). Despite greater lockdowns, mobility continues to increase.

Critical bed capacity has increased steadily since jan-21, yet remains stressed.


#### **Critical beds**

#### **COVID-19 related Deaths**


