


An Update on COVID-19 in Chile

More than 34.6 million vaccines have been administered, with 91% of the target population completing the process. Chile stands out for being the 2nd country with the largest share of population vaccinated with booster doses, reaching 38 per 100 inhabitants. In total, 7.2 million booster doses have been administered.



Chile has received more than 41.9 million vaccines, mostly from SINOVAC and Pfizer-BioNTech.



Cases have slightly increased from last month's record lowest, while PCR test positivity rate has also increased but holding at moderate levels.


COVID-19 Cases in Chile

PCR Test Positivity Rate



Percent deviation with respect to pre-Covid levels




ICU patients have slightly increased, critical bed capacity has moderated.


Critical beds


COVID-19 related Deaths






ICU patients have slightly increased over the last week in 40+ age groups. The average age of ICU patients has maintained stable.
