


## An Update on COVID-19 in Chile


More than 25 million vaccines have been administered, with 82% of the target population completing the process.




Chile has received more than 29 million vaccines, mostly from SINOVAC and Pfizer-BioNTech.


**COVID-19 Vaccine Doses per Supplier: Received & Pending**


## August 9th, 2021

The fall in cases continues to support a gradual relaxation of mobility restricting measures; as of August 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021, only one commune (0.2% of the nation's population) will be in lockdown, down from above 50% a month ago.

## Share of Population per Phase People, Data through August 5<sup>th</sup>.



Nationwide Mobility Percent deviation with respect to pre-Covid levels




With fewer ICU patients and cases falling, critical bed capacity has moderated.
