# An Update on COVID-19 vaccinations in Chile

**Santiago, May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021.** The Government of Chile has made rapid progress in the COVID-19 vaccination effort. Thus far, more than 8.1 million people have received the first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine, equivalent to 53.5% of the target population. Separately, more than 6.7 million people have received a second dose, equivalent to over a third of the target population.

The vaccination schedule has been accelerated, with people aged 40-44 this week and between 35-39 during the week of May 10<sup>th</sup>.

#### Vaccinated Population as of May 2<sup>nd</sup>

- Approximately 8.1 million have received the first dose of a vaccine, equivalent to approximately 53.5% of the target population.
- Roughly 6.7 million people have received the second dose, equivalent to 44.3% of the target population.

#### Vaccine Doses Received

- As of May 3<sup>rd</sup>, Chile has received a total of 17,719,476 doses, composed of 14,971,476 SINOVAC doses, 2,589,600 Pfizer-BioNTech doses, and 158,400 AstraZeneca vaccines (as part of the 818,400 doses within the COVAX Global Alliance agreement of 7.6 million doses).
- The authorities recently announced the purchase of an additional 3 million SINOVAC doses, of which 1.5 million were delivered in Chile yesterday. This new purchase agreement places total SINOVAC doses at 17,098,000.
- The first shipment of CanSino vaccines is expected to be delivered in May, and Pfizer-BioNTech doses will continue to be received regularly.

#### Agreements with Suppliers

The Government of Chile has agreements with the following suppliers:

- SINOVAC: 17.098.000 (double dose)
- Pfizer-BioNTech: 10,100,025 doses (double dose)
- COVAX Global Alliance: 7.6 million doses (double dose)
- AstraZeneca: up to 4 million doses (double dose)
- Johnson & Johnson: up to 4 million doses (mono dose)
- CanSino: 1.8 million doses (mono dose)

The Government continues to negotiate the purchase of additional COVID-19 vaccines.






#### Administered Vaccines (First Dose) by age Group & Gender



## Cumulative COVID-19 vaccination doses administered per 100 people


